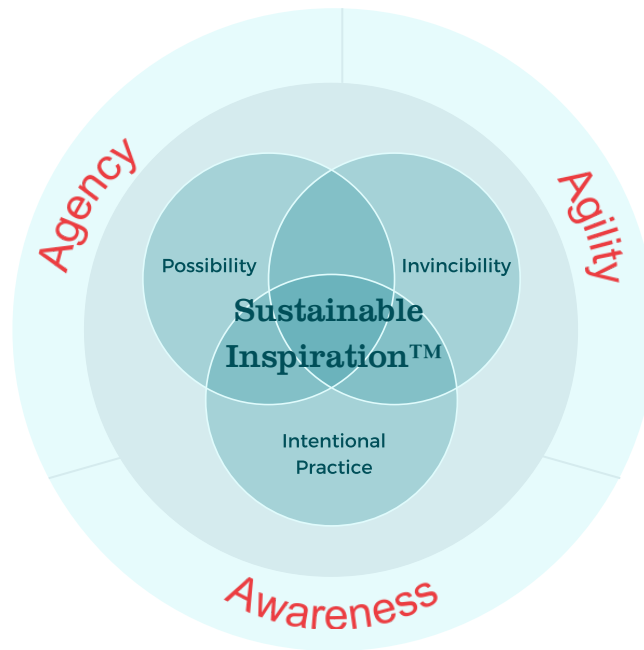


## INITIATIVE COMMITTEE OBJECTIVES
